

Life Group Discussion Questions

*** This guide intentionally has more questions than your group could reasonably discuss in one meeting. Feel free to pick and choose questions that best encourage, challenge, and instruct your particular participants.

Read John 1:1-18

- 1. What does it mean for Christ to come? Who, when, where, why, how? What will it mean when Christ comes again?
- 2. How can you intentionally enter someone else's life to serve them? Are you allowing a difference in status or circumstance to keep you from sharing the gospel or discipling others? What does this do to people who do not know Christ? How can we fix that?
- 3. Anything we consider to increase our standing with God aside from Jesus is wrong. Do you struggle with this? Would you explain this concept the same way to believers as unbelievers?



- 4. God dwelt among His people in the tabernacle. Then He dwelt among us in the flesh. How does He dwell among us now? How did He dwell among people in the beginning? What are the differences and similarities between how God has dwelt among us?
- 5. How low must God condescend to be with us in our sin and depravity? Consider the creator of all things putting up with our issues... does that make you love him more? Should that remind you to not put up barriers to serving others?
- 6. The law came from Moses but grace upon grace came from Jesus. How much grace? Do you deserve grace? Do others deserve grace? We all receive the grace of Jesus, but what is the impact to our witness when we withhold grace from others? What happens when we act like we don't need grace?
- 7. What holiday traditions do you have that honor God? What holiday traditions do you have that do not honor God? What did Jesus say about traditions?
- 8. Intentionality is the key. How can you be more intentional with your traditions? Where is the line between acceptable tradition and inappropriate practice? What does Romans 14 say about it?
- 9. Do you allow the history of traditions to pull you into arguments? How do you show love through disagreements about tradition?



10. How much of an impact did tradition have on the Jews? Are some of the traditions good and honoring to God? Are some of the traditions devoid of relationship with God? How can we ensure our traditions honor God?
