Read Psalm 100:1-5.

1. Are you delighting in God? Where does your mind go to when you are alone? What does your attention go to? What do your dollars go to?
2. God is best served with joy. If you are not serving joyfully, should you still serve?
3. We are not self-made. Do you struggle with that? Do you think that everything you have accomplished is because of your own work?
4. God's ownership of us is reflective of His love for us. How does that affect your life? Are there any other relationships like that?
5. God meets your needs emotionally, spiritually, relationally, and physically. Do you feel all of those equally, or at all? Why do you think that is?
6. If you feel distant from God, just sit down and make a list of how thankful you are. Have you done this? Do you tend to make lists of complaints instead?
