PSALM 81

- ¹ Sing aloud to God our strength; shout for joy to the God of Jacob!
- ² Raise a song; sound the tambourine, the sweet lyre with the harp.
- ³ Blow the trumpet at the new moon, at the full moon, on our feast day.
- ⁴ For it is a statute for Israel, a rule of the God of Jacob.
- ⁵ He made it a decree in Joseph when he went out over the land of Egypt.

I hear a language I had not known:

- ⁶ "I relieved your shoulder of the burden; your hands were freed from the basket.
- ⁷ In distress you called, and I delivered you; I answered you in the secret place of thunder;

I tested you at the waters of Meribah. Selah

⁸ Hear, O my people, while I admonish you! O Israel, if you would but listen to me!

- ⁹ There shall be no strange god among you; you shall not bow down to a foreign god.
- ¹⁰ I am the Lord your God, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt.

Open your mouth wide, and I will fill it.

- 11 "But my people did not listen to my voice; Israel would not submit to me.
- ¹² So I gave them over to their stubborn hearts,

to follow their own counsels.

- ¹³ Oh, that my people would listen to me, that Israel would walk in my ways!
- ¹⁴ I would soon subdue their enemies and turn my hand against their foes.
- ¹⁵ Those who hate the Lord would cringe toward him.
